#### **Weather Policy**

These boats are designed to operate in all weather conditions. There may be times, however, when it's simply too nasty outside for this adventure to be enjoyable. In the event the program is cancelled due to weather, unforeseen mechanical problems, etc., there is no refund. We will work with you to reschedule your Sea Ops mission.

#### Location

Training takes place at our maritime operations training center in Hull, MA, about an hour's drive from Boston's Logan Airport. (Note: Mobile training teams are available. If you'd like a custom boating operation near you, please contact us for a special quote.)

#### **Accommodations**

### **Physical Requirement**

This isn't a leisurely day of boating. It's a fun-filled, physically demanding day of adventure. If you have a history of heart problems or back problems, or are pregnant, this mission isn't for you. It is solely your responsibility to determine if you are physically fit for this adventure. You will be required to sign a Release of Liability as a condition of participation.

#### **Age Requirement**

Anyone under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and must receive special permission to participate from our mission leader. There is no maximum age allowed.

#### Uniform

You will need to supply your own sweater/sweatshirt, rain jacket and closed-toe rubber sole shoes.
